Directions for filling out an application:

- A. Read the entire application form thoroughly to best understand the information needed to complete the form.
- B. Complete the form in ink or use typewriter.
- C. Be sure to answer all questions.

You will also need the following to complete your application:

Two letters of recommendation need to be filled out by acceptable references. Examples of acceptable reference would be former or current employers, instructors or past teachers, WUMFA members or others in positions of responsibility that can objectively speak to your qualities. (Does not include relatives & close friends). If you are not an Active WUMFA member or currently working for an Active WUMFA member then your one letter of recommendation need to come from someone who is an Active WUMFA member (the shop owner not an employee) or an Associate teacher WUMFA member.

A photograph taken of you within the last twelve months, which may be used for publicity purposes should the applicant receive a grant. The photo is non-returnable.

Scholarship description:

The Wisconsin & Upper Michigan Floral Association Scholarships awarded will be up to \$250.00. This scholarship may be used for Annual Convention registration with the exception of the Saturday evening recognition banquet, Certified Florist program, or any WUMFA Educational workshop or class. All scholarships awarded are valid for a 12-month period. Any funds not used in the 12-month time frame will be rolled back into the WUMFA general scholarship fund. The scholarship will be issued in the form of a credit voucher. Applicants are chosen on the basis of their individual motivation toward a floriculture career path.

Eligibility Requirements:

Applicant must be employed and working in the Floriculture industry or show proof of enrollment in a course of study directly related to the retail Floriculture industry.

Applicant must have clearly defined career goal, which relates directly to the industry's course of study.
